



## 2021 Lair Private Party COVID-19 Guidelines

Private parties and mixers have been a long-standing tradition at the Lair and will always be. COVID-19 pandemic circumstances require special guidelines for the health and safety of all campers and staff; the parties and mixers are no exception. In order to allow such events to continue during the 2021 Lair Bridge year in a safe manner, all private parties, mixers, and similar activities (events) SHALL comply with the following guidelines:

1. All attendees must wear masks if not vaccinated and social distancing is not possible. Masks must be worn properly covering both the nose and mouth.
2. Hand sanitizer must be available at the entrance to the event and where food and beverages are distributed.
3. All beverages must be served in either their original bottles or cans, or in disposable cups.
4. All beverages must be served by a designated bartender, including bottle or canned adult beverages or soft drinks. Self-serve coolers, ice chests, or other types of dispensers are strictly prohibited. If coolers, ice chests, or dispensers are used, they must be accessible to, and used only by, the bartender.
5. All food items must be pre-packaged or supplied by the camp kitchen. Campers may supply food items only if they are provided in individual, manufacturer-sealed, single-serve packages. Examples are items such as lunch box sized bags of chips, trail mix or nuts purchased in single-serving packages, etc.
6. Sharing of food or beverages is strictly prohibited.
7. Any member of the Lair staff is authorized to terminate any event in violation of the guidelines in effect at the time of the event or if they determine the event to be unsafe. In such a case, the hosts shall cooperate with immediately shutting down the event.
8. The health and safety of all campers and staff at the Lair is, and has always been, the top priority. The COVID-19 situation is unpredictable and constantly changing, therefore, the Lair reserves the right to, at any time and without advance notice:
  - a. Cancel any or all events.
  - b. Modify these guidelines as necessary and appropriate to the circumstances.

All Lair campers agree to abide by all guidelines in effect at that time.
