

- Explore the Southwest's natural wonders with a knowledgeable Orbridge Expedition Leader.

Welcome to the City of Lights, Vegas style. Embrace the comforts of your tastefully-appointed, modern guest room.









To confirm and secure your reservation, a deposit of \$850 per person per program, a deposit for any extension(s), and any non-refundable advanced payments, payable by check, ACH, money order, wire transfer of same day U.S. funds, or major credit card, is due at the time of registration. Final payment, including any extension(s) and optional(s), is payable by check, ACH, money order, or wire transfer of same day U.S. funds and due no later than 90 days prior to the scheduled program departure date.

Cancellations and Refunds.
